ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ONLINE

ENTRIES CLOSE NOVEMBER 3, 2021

1. **OWNERSHIP:** All entries must be owned or leased by exhibitors who reside in Pennsylvania. If the animal is leased, an executed lease agreement must be completed by the entry deadline and be presented at check-in. No limited leases are permitted. All entries will be subject to the General Rules, Regulations & Health Requirements (link above); entry fees can be found there. **STALLING:** Horses will be accepted subject to stall availability. If all horses cannot be accommodated due to space limitations, multiple-hitch exhibitors will only be permitted to bring one spare horse. Every attempt will be made to accommodate stalling requests. Once stalls are assigned, exhibitors are NOT permitted to make changes unless reviewed and approved by the committee. Tack stalls will be limited based on the number of available stalls.
2. **NEW:** All exhibitors are REQUIRED to show all horses in their respective halter classes. If an exhibitor has more than two eligible horses in a class, the exhibitor is required to show at least two horses in that class. An exhibitor may show more than two horses in any one class but premiums will only be paid for the two highest placings.
3. **HEALTH:** A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection, Equine Infectious Anemia Testing, and Rabies vaccination are all required. Refer to the link above for additional Health Requirements.
4. **CONDUCT:** Any unsportsmanlike conduct or inappropriate behavior towards horses or people will result in disqualification of the exhibitor, forfeiture of **ALL** premiums, and exhibitor will be required to leave the grounds immediately. Further action will be pending. The use of shock collars or other similar devices will result in disqualification from the show and forfeiture of **ALL** premiums. If the Show Chairs or Show Manager suspects the use of such a device, they may request to inspect any harness or piece of equipment. Refusal to allow inspection may result in disqualification from the show and forfeiture of **ALL** premiums.
5. **FAILURE TO EXHIBIT:** Any exhibitor whose entries are accepted for the show and who for two consecutive years fails to exhibit their animals shall be accepted for the following year only if extra space is available. A penalty of \$100 per animal will be assessed to the owner of each horse, dairy, or beef animal entered and not exhibited (shown) at the Farm Show. Entries cancelled on or before November 3, 2021, will permit a refund of entry fees with no penalty. Entry cancellations received on or before December 23, 2021, will cause forfeiture of entry fees without penalty. In **extreme or unusual circumstances**, a veterinarian excuse or a written appeal of the assessment of the penalty will be considered if received by the **Farm Show Manager** on or before January 17, 2022. Failure to pay the assessed penalty will result in disqualification from future Farm Show competitions. Substitutions are permissible with committee approval.
6. **ARRIVAL:** Horses may begin arriving at 1 p.m. on Wednesday, January 5, 2022. All horses must be in place by 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 6, 2022 unless prior approval is given by the Committee Chair(s). The Equine Barn will be open to exhibitors for setup and displays on Sunday January 2, 2022, Monday, January 3, 2022, and Tuesday, January 4, 2022. All other areas will be available to exhibitors as stalls are set up.
7. **CHECK-IN:** Check-in time for draft horses will be on Thursday, January 6, 2022, from 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the stalls. A driver's meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, January 7, 2022 in the Equine Barn. All additional (post) group class and hitch class entries must be made no later than when exhibitor's entries are checked in to the show. Paperwork needed for check-in: registration papers, leases, and card from veterinary check-in upon arrival to show grounds.
8. **RELEASE:** Draft horses will be permitted to be released upon completion of the classes entered. Any exhibit removed prior to the listed times without Show Management approval will result in forfeiture of **ALL** premiums. All exhibitors must be out of the barns prior to 8:00 a.m. Monday, January 10, 2022.
9. **WRIST BANDS:** Exhibitors and helpers must wear wristbands for identification purposes when entering and leaving the arena and stable area on show day. Wrist bands will be distributed at check-in.
10. **ATTIRE:** Dress shall be appropriate for the class. **Blue jeans are not permitted in the ring for any reason except** in the western riding classes if worn with chaps and the feed scurry. Should you present in the ring with blue jeans, you will be asked to leave to change to suitable attire.
11. Show Management reserves the right to split, combine, or eliminate classes.
12. **YOUTH:** Youth Drivers must be 8-19 years of age, as of December 31, 2021, and must be accompanied by an adult. Age divisions to include Senior (16-19), Intermediate (12-15), and Junior (8-11). Adjustments may be made at the discretion of the show committee. Exhibitors competing in Classes 170, 172, 174-184, and 188-191 are not eligible for youth competition.
13. **SCORING:** Scoring for the judging of all riding classes is as follows: Adult riding will be judged 40% equitation and 60% horse. Youth riding will be judged 60% equitation and 40% horse. The horse component will include performance, manners/suitability, soundness, and turnout. **All riders are required to wear a helmet at all times while riding.** FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS RULE WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION AND POSSIBLE FORFEITURE OF ALL PREMIUMS.
14. Vehicles will be allowed into the building for hitching at the discretion of the Horse Committee.
15. **NEW: SHOW ORDER:** Show Order will be announced at Check-In.

Do not remove panels from any stall.

Exhibitors will be charged \$50 per panel for all panels removed without permission.

Contact the Horse Show Office if you need panels removed.

DRAFT HORSE HALTER SHOW

Friday, January 7, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. - Equine Arena - Halter Classes followed by Adult and Youth Riding Classes

1. ENTRY: Only horses representative of the mainstream draft horse breeds in the United States, that include but are not limited to, Belgian, Percheron, Clydesdale, Shire, Suffolk, and Spotted Draft will be accepted. Horses not meeting draft standards will not be permitted to show. No light horses or cross breeds with light horses are permitted. Cross breeds based on acceptable draft horse breeds are permitted.
2. **NEW:** All exhibitors are REQUIRED to show all horses in their respective halter classes. If an exhibitor has **more** than two eligible horses in a class, the exhibitor is required to show at least two horses in that class. An exhibitor may show more than two horses in any one class but premiums will only be paid for the two highest placings.
3. Halter classes, at the discretion of Show Management, may be combined, shown together, but placed separately. A horse must be shown in its respective breed class to be eligible to be shown in a group class(es).

Halter Group Classes Defined:

1. In all classes except get-of-sire and produce of mare, all animals must be owned by one exhibitor. Mixed ownership within one family not permitted.
2. Junior Get-of-Sire: To consist of two animals, 2 years and under, either sex, the get of one sire.
3. Open Get-of-Sire: To consist of two animals, any age, either sex, the get of one sire. An animal can be shown only in one get-of-sire class.
4. Produce of Mare: To consist of two animals, either sex, the produce of one mare.

Saturday, January 8, 2022, not before 11:30 a.m. - Equine Arena - Tandem & Cart Classes

Sunday, January 9, 2022, at 12:30 - Large Arena - Multiple Hitch Classes

- ENTRY: Only horses representing the breeds of Belgian, Percheron, Clydesdale, and Shire will be accepted. A horse shown in a Draft Horse Hitched Class (Section 005) is ineligible to be shown in a Draft Horse Pleasure Class (Section 0007) with an exception made for Class 195 (Feed Scurry). **FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS RULE MAY RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF ALL PREMIUMS.**
- SCORING: Scoring for the judging of all hitch classes is as follows: 60% - Manners and performance; 20% - Conformation (appearance of horse or horses); and 20% - Appointments (wagons, harness).
- In Classes 174 through 187, horse must be hitched to a suitable two-wheeled cart. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry in Classes 188 through 191.
- No stallions are permitted in youth cart classes and all riding classes.
- A reasonable amount of time will be allowed for tack changes for Classes 174-187. The amount of time will be at the discretion of the judge.
- Multiple hitch classes are limited to classic fifth wheel show wagon.
- BORROWED HORSES: Two horses may be borrowed for the Six Horse Hitch class, and one horse may be borrowed for the Four Horse Hitch class. Borrowed horses are not permitted in any other classes. Six hitched horses may be comprised of ownership to include not more than two exhibitors.
- All multiple hitches must be made up of horses of the same breed.
- The winner of the Team Hitch class may be offered the opportunity to drive the Governor into the Large Arena the following year.
- CHAMPION HITCH EXHIBITOR - Placings from Classes 188, 189, 190, 191, and 192 will be used to determine the Champion Hitch Exhibitor. Points will be awarded based on the number of entries shown in the class. All tiebreaker decisions will be made by the judge.
- All Feed Scurry teams (horses and teamsters) will be limited to one attempt. All drivers (teamsters) must be 14 years of age and older for this class. Bale throwers may participate multiple times. This is a timed event.

ENTRY: Only horses representative of the mainstream draft horse breeds in the United States, that include but are not limited to, Belgian, Percheron, Clydesdale, Shire, Suffolk, and Spotted Draft will be accepted. Horses not meeting draft standards will not be permitted to show. No light horses or cross breeds with light horses are permitted. Cross breeds based on acceptable draft horse breeds are permitted. A horse shown in a Draft Horse Hitched Class (Section 005) is ineligible to be shown in a Draft Horse Pleasure Class (Section 0007) with an exception made for Class 195 (Feed Scurry). **FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS RULE MAY RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF ALL PREMIUMS.**
2. No scotch housing permitted. There are no shoeing requirements.
3. BORROWED HORSES: Borrowing horses is not permitted.
4. SCORING: Scoring for the judging of all hitch classes is as follows: 60% - Manners and performance; 20% - Conformation (appearance of horse or horses); and 20% - Appointments (wagons, harness).
5. In Classes 210 and 211, horse must be hitched to a suitable two-wheeled cart.
6. WAGONS: Any suitable four-wheel show vehicle will be permitted. All other non-standard show wagons must enter Class 217.
7. **NEW: SHOW ORDER: Show Order** will be announced at Check-In.

ENTRY: Only horses representative of the mainstream draft horse breeds in the United States, that include but are not limited to, Belgian, Percheron, Clydesdale, Shire, Suffolk, and Spotted Draft will be accepted. Horses not meeting draft standards will not be permitted to show. No light horses or cross breeds with light horses are permitted. Cross breeds based on acceptable draft horse breeds are permitted.
2. Exhibitors must be 8-19, years of age as of December 31, 2021. Age divisions to include Senior (16-19), Intermediate (12-15), and Junior (8-11). Adjustments may be made at the discretion of the show committee.
3. YOUTH DECORATING: Exhibitors will be allowed 30 minutes in the ring to roll a mane and tail only and present their horse to the judge. No showmanship will be required for this class.
4. YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP: Youth to be judged on their ability to show a draft horse.
5. No stallions are permitted in Youth classes.
6. DRIVERS: Youth Drivers must be accompanied by an adult. Drivers competing in Classes 170, 172, 174-184, and 188-191 are not eligible for youth competition.
7. SCORING: Scoring for the judging of all riding classes is as follows: Adult riding will be judged 40% equitation and 60% horse. Youth riding will be judged 60% equitation and 40% horse. The horse component will include performance, manners/suitability, soundness, and turnout.

YOUTH HIGH POINT AWRAD

In the classes where Seniors, Intermediates, and Juniors show together, points will be calculated by division. Example: Youth Decorating – first place a senior, second place a senior, third place a junior, fourth place a senior. In this case, the third-place junior would receive first-place points and the fourth-place senior would receive third-place points.

BEST STALL DECORATION

Points will be awarded in four categories that will include: 1) Neatness of display and barn aisle area, 2) Educational value, 3) Courtesy and interaction of the exhibitors, 4) Display of farm/exhibitor names and location. Points will be awarded for neat, workmanlike tack room/barn aisle area. Extensive decoration is not necessary. The display should include some portion that would help educate the general public toward the use and ownership of the draft horse. Neatness and uniformity of the barn aisle will be rewarded. Courtesy and interaction with the viewing public is expected and will also be rewarded. No extra points will be awarded for displays that exceed that needed for a workmanlike show operation. Judging will occur Friday-Sunday.

1. There will be two classes: Lightweight for teams weighing 3,425 pounds and under and heavyweight for teams weighing more than 3,425 pounds.
2. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ONLIE.** Entries close November 3, 2021.
3. **FAILURE TO EXHIBIT:** Any exhibitor whose entries are accepted for the show and who for two consecutive years fails to exhibit his animals shall be accepted for the following year only if extra space is available. A penalty of \$100 will be assessed to the owner of each team entered and not exhibited (shown) at the Farm Show.
