ENTRIES CLOSE NOVEMBER 3, 2021

1. All entries will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations.
2. Health: Refer to the link above for Health Requirements.
3. Eligibility: These classes are open to 4-H Club and FFA members. Exhibitors must have been born from 2002 through 2012 inclusive. Exhibitors must be 4-H members carrying an alpaca project under the supervision of the Pennsylvania State University Agricultural Extension Service or a dues-paying FFA member carrying an alpaca project under the supervision of a Pennsylvania Vocational Agricultural Instructor.
4. Entries will be limited to one entry per exhibitor per class. Show Management reserves the right to accept or deny any entries.
5. Entry fee \$8.00 per exhibitor.
6. Animals may begin arriving at noon on Monday, January 10, 2022, and will be housed in horse stalls. Straw will be provided. No turf will be provided and is not permitted. Exhibitors may bring their own bedding.
7. All show entries must be in place and checked in by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, January 10, 2022.
8. All animals will be released at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, January 11, 2022, and must vacate by 6 a.m. on Wednesday, January 12, 2022. Any exhibitor violating the release time or other Farm Show rules or regulations may lose the privilege of showing at a future show or be subject to other appropriate action as deemed necessary by the Farm Show Manager, including but not limited to forfeiting all premiums.
9. Youth age divisions include junior 9-12, intermediate 13-15, and senior 16-19.
10. Contest rules will be patterned after the Alpaca Owners Association rules.
11. All exhibitors will be permitted an obstacle course walk-through without animals prior to first competition class performance. Patterns will be posted during check-in.
12. Competition will be operated with two show rings. Showmanship classes will begin with the Senior Division. Obstacle classes will begin with the Junior Division.
13. Alpacas must be shown in a naturally clean pasture condition wearing a well-fitted halter and lead. The Alpaca may not wear any other ornamental item, nor have toenails or fleece painted in any way. Training aids such as clickers and treats may not be used in the show ring.
14. Exhibitors must wear a white shirt and black pants. Only closed toe and closed heel shoes are permitted in the show ring.
