ENTRIES MUST BE DROPPED OFF AT THE FARM SHOW COMPLEX BETWEEN 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. DECEMBER 4 & 5, 2020

1. All Vegetable Department entries must have been grown by the exhibitor in Pennsylvania since the 2020 Farm Show.
2. No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit for competition in any class.
3. No exhibits or packages of vegetables entered in one class shall be eligible to compete in any other class.
4. Any entry delivered without an official entry tag will be disqualified.
5. Upon drop off, all exhibits will become the property of the Farm Show and will not be returned to the exhibitor. Items that meet quality standards will be donated to a food bank.
