ENTRIES MUST BE DROPPED OFF AT THE FARM SHOW COMPLEX BETWEEN 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. DECEMBER 4 & 5, 2020

1. Exhibits shown must have been grown by the exhibitor in Pennsylvania since the 2020 Farm Show.
2. No exhibits or package of mushrooms entered in one class shall be eligible to compete in any other class, except as plainly noted in the Premium List. No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit for competition in any class or division of a class.
3. Misnamed varieties will not be considered disqualified.
4. Any entry delivered without an official entry tag will be disqualified.
5. Upon drop off, all exhibits will become the property of the Farm Show and will not be returned to the exhibitor. Items meeting quality standards will be donated to a food bank.

3 lb. Basket wood or corrugated

- Class 1.** Off white - Button (0.75"-1.25")
Class 2. Off white - Mediums (1.25"-2.25")
Class 3. Off white - Large (2.25" - 2.75")
Class 4. Off white - Jumbo (2.75" and up)

Specialty

- Other edible mushroom crops not listed above. Best display of overwrap and bulk, fresh, or dry. Only one (1) entry per species per individual in this class: for example, Shiitake, Portobello, etc.
- Class 5.** Shiitake (3 lbs.)
Class 6. Oyster (3 lbs.)
Class 7. Baby Portobello/Crimini (3 or 5 lbs.)
Class 8. Portobello bulk (3 or 5 lbs.)
Class 9. Other (can include beech, maitake, enoki, etc.)
