ENTRIES CLOSE DECEMBER 1, 2021

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ONLINE

1. Any individual, farm, family, address, or partnership is limited to a maximum of 50 entries. Entries will be received up to the closing date of December 1, 2020, if space is available and shall be based approximately on the following allocation: LARGE FOWL, DUCKS, AND GUINEAS 400; BANTAMS 300; GEESE AND TURKEYS 100. Section totals can be adjusted to not exceed 800 total entries.
 - a. All poultry exhibited at the Pennsylvania Farm Show must be owned by the exhibitor and housed in Pennsylvania from the time entry is made until exhibited at the Farm Show.
2. Not more than TWO entries may be entered in one class by one exhibitor. (*For example, one exhibitor may not enter more than two White Rock cockerels*). NO SUBSTITUTION of entries may be made after closing date of entries.
3. The showroom will be open to receive birds from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, January 7, 2022. All exhibitors must be checked in by the PDA Health official by 6 p.m. ALL entries must be in their coops by 6:30 p.m. NO exceptions will be made. Any birds NOT cooped by 6:30 p.m. will not be allowed in the show, NO exceptions. All birds will be strictly observed for general health at check-in. Birds showing any respiratory symptoms or signs of scaly leg, severely frozen combs or toes, or are extremely dirty or in poor feather condition will be denied entry into the show. Birds should appear to be in good health and body condition for breed and/or age. The birds can be cooped only under the supervision of the Show Management.
 - a. Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 8, 2022, in the East Hall.
 - b. All birds will be released on Saturday, January 15, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. and must be removed by 7:00 p.m. Birds must be cooped out under the supervision of Show Management.
 - c. All birds will be fed and watered daily during Farm Show.
 - d. An awards program and exhibitor meeting will be held in the show area at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 8, 2022.
4. Management reserves the right to make any alterations that may seem desirable for the best interests of the show.
5. No specimen is to be handled by anyone other than the owner, judge, or a representative of Show Management, unless permission is given by the owner.
6. No person shall interfere with the judges in any manner while in the performance of their duties. Judges will be encouraged by the management to give exhibitors reasons for awarding a prize or for discriminating against a bird. Such information can be given after the judge has finished placing awards for a particular breed or variety.
7. No name and no distinctive marks or decorations will be allowed on the coops until after the premiums have been awarded.
8. Any useful advertising material approved by the Show Manager may be placed on the cages after the awards are made.
9. To compete for display prizes donated by the State Farm Show Commission, an exhibitor of standard chickens, bantams, or waterfowl must exhibit at least seven individuals of one variety, including **AT LEAST ONE** cock, hen, cockerel, and pullet. All ties shall be broken by the subsequent decision of the judge.
10. **Sale of poultry is prohibited until after the birds have been cooped out by the exhibitor with supervision of Show Management or premiums will be forfeited.**
11. All awards for display made by State Farm Show Commission will be decided in the following manner: First prize counts six points, second prize four points, third prize three points, fourth prize two points, fifth prize one point. Each prize to be multiplied by the number exhibited in the class. (*For example, first-prize Silver Wyandotte cockerel with 15 in class counts 90 points*).

Health Requirements

1. **Identification:** All Pennsylvania poultry, waterfowl, upland game birds, and ratites entering an exhibition must bear a unique individual identification leg band (an official PDA leg band is required for all birds entering the show, and these bands are available free of charge through your PDA regional veterinarian).
2. **Owner-Endorsed Health Certificate:** An official Owner-Endorsed Poultry Health Certificate must accompany all entries to the show and will be collected prior to cooping at the show premises. This certificate must be endorsed with the poultry owner's signature.
3. All animals must be free of infectious, contagious, and external parasitic diseases. Animals appearing unhealthy upon arrival will not be allowed into the Farm Show Complex.

4. **Testing Requirements: Owner must complete and bring to show “Official Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate for All Exhibition Birds and their Hatching Eggs” found on page 9-10 & 9-11. A complete review of the Department of Agriculture’s General Quarantine Order; Poultry Exhibition Requirements found at <https://www.agriculture.pa.gov/Animals/AHDServices/Documents/Poultry%20show%20OO%20published%20June%202019.pdf> is recommended.**

(c). **Vaccinations:** No vaccinations of any kind shall be administered less than thirty (30) days before cooping day of the show.

5. **All crates and coops used to transport poultry to and from the Farm Show shall be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected before and after such use.**

GENERAL CLASSIFICATIONS

Large Chickens - Classes will be provided for all varieties listed in the Premium List for cock, hen, cockerel, and pullet.

Bantams - Classes will be provided for all varieties listed in the Premium List for cock, hen, cockerel, and pullet.

Geese - Classes will be provided for all varieties listed in the Premium List for old gander, old goose, young gander, and young goose.

Ducks - Classes will be provided for all varieties listed in the Premium List for old drake, old duck, young drake, and young duck.

Turkeys - Classes will be provided for all varieties listed in the Premium List for old tom, old hen, young tom, and young hen.

Guineas - Classes will be provided for all varieties listed in the Premium List for cock, hen, cockerel, and pullet.

JUNIOR AWARDS

An APA Medal plus one (1) year Junior Membership will be given for the following Champions shown by junior exhibitors: Champion Large Chicken, Champion Bantam Chicken, Champion Duck, Champion Goose, Champion Turkey. Juniors need not be members to receive these junior awards. All judging shall be by the latest edition of the American Standard of Perfection, copyrighted by the American Poultry Association, Inc. Dues will be accepted in the showroom prior to judging or they may be sent to: American Poultry Association, Pat Horstman, Secretary, PO Box 306, Burgettstown, PA 15021. Phone: 724-729-3459. Dues must be paid prior to judging to be eligible for APA awards. APA District Director is Dick Horstman. APA State Representative is Roland Romig.

AMERICAN BANTAM ASSOCIATION *Special Meet*

Plaques to Champion and Reserve Champion Bantam.

Pins for Champion and Reserve for all seven bantam divisions providing there are 25 birds competing.

Pins for all starred wins in the show.

Only ABA members are eligible to compete for the above awards. Dues are \$25.00 per year, \$70.00 for three years. New members receive a copy of the quarterly and the latest available copy of the Annual American Bantam Association Yearbook, which lists 900 advertisers and includes a complete breed and variety index. Winners of ABA awards are listed in the yearbook under Who's Who in Bantams. Starred wins are earned by Champions and Reserve Champions in the seven bantam divisions when the number of birds competing is 100 or more. Starred wins are also awarded to Best and Reserve of Breed and Variety when 100 or more birds are competing. A single bird is eligible for only one award and can earn only one starred win. *****Awards are subject to change. The certificate must be presented to exhibition management prior to cooping of all avian species or display of hatching eggs. This owner-endorsed health certificate *must* be endorsed with the bird owner's signature.

3. Verification of Testing for all poultry, including chickens, turkeys, waterfowl, game birds (such as pheasants, partridge, quail, grouse, and guineas), ratites, and hatching eggs (all samples must be collected by a Certified Poultry Technician or a Category II Accredited Veterinarian):

a. Avian influenza testing and verification:

i. National Animal Health Laboratory Network (NAHLN) protocols for sample collection, including the number of swabs/tube of viral transport media (see vi and vii below), and testing shall be followed. All samples must be tested at a NAHLN laboratory.

ii. All poultry, including chickens, turkeys, waterfowl, game birds, and ratites, and their hatching eggs must originate from a flock in which a random, representative sample of a minimum of 30 birds, three (3) weeks of age or older, were tested for avian influenza within the 30 days prior to entry into the exhibition.

iii. If there are fewer than 30 birds in the flock, all birds of age must be tested.

iv. Test results must be negative.

v. All poultry and hatching eggs must be accompanied by the most recent test report (photocopies are acceptable).

vi. Chickens, turkeys, game birds, and ratites may meet the testing requirements with blood testing or tracheal/oropharyngeal swab testing. If swab samples are collected, swabs from different species — e.g. chickens and turkeys — may not be combined in a tube of viral transport media (BHI). If 5 or fewer swabs are collected per tube, the swab tips may be left in the tube. If between 5 and 11 swabs per tube are collected, swirl the swab tip in the BHI liquid, press the swab tip against the inner surface of the tube to remove excess material into the tube, and discard the swab in a biosecure manner.

vii. Waterfowl such as ducks and geese must be tested with cloacal swab samples. Swabs from different species — e.g. ducks and geese — may not be combined in a tube of viral transport media (BHI). Up to 5 swabs may be placed per tube for waterfowl testing. Swab tips may be left in the tube.

viii. Poultry not meeting the testing requirements shall not be comingled with or added to the tested flock after negative samples have been collected and before poultry or hatching eggs enter the exhibition.

b. Pullorum-typhoid testing and verification:

i. National Animal Health Laboratory Network (NAHLN) protocols for sample collection and testing shall be

- ii. Poultry, including chickens, turkeys, game birds, and ratites (waterfowl are excluded), and their hatching eggs:
 - (1). Must originate from a flock currently enrolled, tested, and in good standing on the NPIP Pullorum-typhoid Clean Program, with no break in the chain of ownership by NPIP participants, and the poultry or hatching eggs must be accompanied by the most recent laboratory test report or 9-3 form (*Report of Sales of Hatching Eggs, Chicks, or Poults*) which includes the NPIP number; or NPIP 9-2 form (*Flock Selecting and Testing Report*) for the rapid whole blood agglutination plate test which includes the NPIP number (photocopies are acceptable); or
 - (2). Must originate from a flock currently enrolled, tested, and in good standing on the PA Pullorum Equivalent Program, with no break in the chain of ownership by program participants, and the poultry or hatching eggs must be accompanied by the most recent laboratory test report which includes the program enrollment number, or state rapid test reporting form for the rapid whole blood agglutination plate test for pullorum-typhoid which includes the program enrollment number (photocopies are acceptable); or
 - (3). All individual poultry, including chickens, turkeys, game birds, and ratites (waterfowl are excluded), or poultry providing hatching eggs (maximum of 300 from a flock) entering a Pennsylvania exhibition must have had a pullorum-typhoid test within the ninety (90) days prior to the opening date of the exhibition. The poultry or hatching eggs must be accompanied by the most recent laboratory test report; or the Department’s rapid test reporting form for the rapid whole blood agglutination plate test for pullorum-typhoid performed on non-NPIP birds (photocopies are acceptable).
 - (4). Test results must be negative.
 - (5). The following age restrictions apply for pullorum-typhoid testing:
 - ◆ Chickens shall be tested at 4 months of age or older.
 - ◆ Turkeys shall be tested at 12 weeks of age or older.
 - ◆ Game birds shall be tested at 4 months of age or older, or upon sexual maturity, whichever comes first.
 - ◆ Ratites shall be tested at 12 months of age or older.
 - ◆ Poultry which is individually tested for pullorum for exhibition must have a negative pullorum test if of age at the time of entry into the exhibition.

- 4. **Bird identification:** All poultry, including chickens, turkeys, waterfowl and game birds entering an exhibition must bear an individual **OFFICIAL STATE LEG BAND**. For PA poultry , official crimp-style leg bands will show “PDA” on the bands, and official Butt-end band numbers begin with the prefix “PA”. Ratites must be identified with a neck band or an electronic implant device (the exhibitor must supply a reader). Pigeons, doves, and other avian species such as psittacines and passerines must bear a unique individual identification leg band (official state leg bands are not required except for poultry).
